## **Engineer Of The Year**

The San Joaquin Joint Engineers Council makes its Engineer of the Year award each year during the annual Banquet. The award is for meritorious and altruistic service to the engineering profession and to the community.

Nominees shall be sponsored by one of the member professional organizations or by members of SJEC's Board of Directors. All nominees shall work or reside within the SJEC jurisdiction. Nominations shall be made using the official nomination form attached hereto.

The nomination form and supporting data shall show that the nominee is a graduate or registered engineer and shown exceptional dedication and made significant contributions to the engineering profession and the community without expectation of financial reward.

The recipient must have dedicated their professional knowledge and skills to the advancement of human welfare, participated in none but honest enterprises and lived and worked according to the highest standards of professional conduct; to have placed service before profit, the honor and standing of their profession before personal advantage, and the public welfare above all other considerations.

The Engineer of the Year (EOY) Committee, consisting of past award recipients, will give timely notice to members of the Board of Directors and member organizations of their privilege to nominate and the rules therefore by announcement in December of each year.

Nominations and names of Nominees shall be kept strictly confidential. The Official Nominees will be selected by the EOY Committee from nominations received from Member Societies or Board Members on or before January 1. Each name must be accompanied by details supporting meritorious service indicated on the application form.

The award recipient will be selected by approval of Governing Board in executive session at its January Meeting, of "Official Nominees" presented by the EOY Committee.

The outgoing EOY Committee shall serve through February before being relieved by the succeeding Committee, at which time it may, at its discretion, may destroy its record of nominations or forward all or part to the succeeding Committee.
